Winning students will receive a certificate and the following cash prizes:

1st Place: \$2000 2nd Place: \$1500 3rd Place: \$1000 4th Place: \$750

1st place will have their design printed and used by the Masonic Charity Foundation of Oklahoma as one of their 2027 Winter Holiday cards!

1st place winner's Art Program or Teacher will also receive \$2000!

DESIGN CRITERIA:

- **Theme:** The card design should reflect a winter holiday or winter seasonal theme and convey a holiday greeting or sentiment. This could be through imagery, a brief message, or both.
- **Medium:** 2-dimensional work or 3-dimensional artwork that when photographed or scanned will print well on a flat card. For example, digital art, watercolor, acrylic, mixed media, pen and ink, etc.
- **Appropriateness:** The content should be respectful and suitable for all audiences.
- **Size:** Design should fit inside a 5x7 inches or 7x5 inches box in order to fit on a card.

CONTEST DETAILS:

- Any Oklahoma public school student is eligible and may submit one entry.
- Submissions will be digitally accepted from October 1, 2026 thru January 31, 2027.
- Designs must be submitted in .PDF, .JPEG, or .PNG format.
- Entries become the property of the Masonic Charity Foundation of Oklahoma.

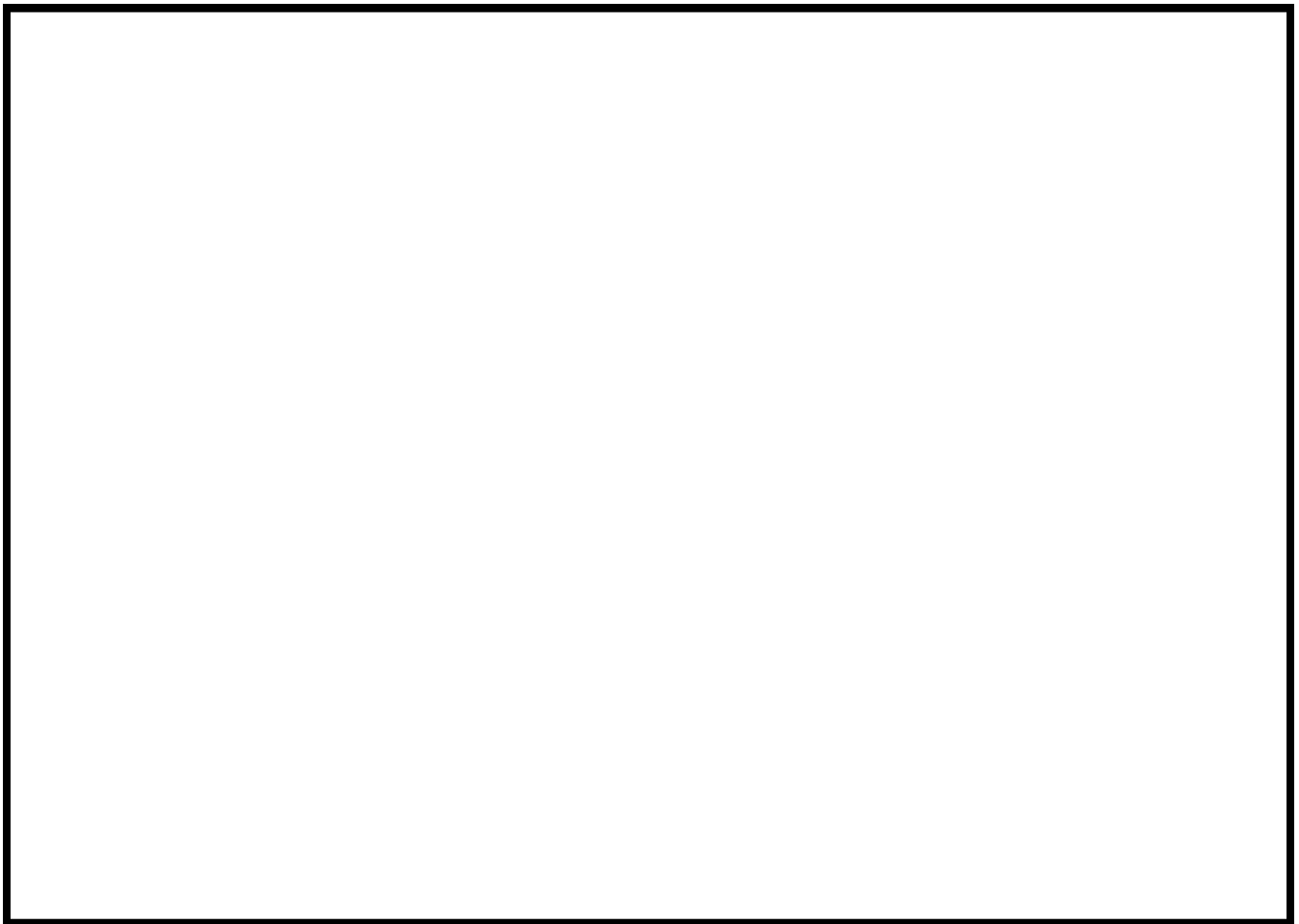
