# Letter from the President

2021



Dear Brethren and Friends,

It is with our deepest gratitude that I thank you for your continued dedication to our Oklahoma communities. Our mission is to impact Oklahomans from all walks of life. 2019 was an exciting year for the Masonic Charity Foundation of Oklahoma. The Oklahoma Area Agencies on Aging received over \$682,000 to assist senior citizens in our state. We continue our steadfast support of **Vizavance** and our Partners in Prevention program. In the 2019-2020 school year, 184,183 students were screened for vision problems through the help of a **\$200,000** grant for operations, and an additional **\$40,000** for new SPOT cameras.

In furtherance of student achievement, it was our 2nd year to sponsor the **Oklahoma High School Ethics Bowl**. The winners, Dove Science Academy, received **\$5,000** in funds to assist in their travel to the national competition in Chapel Hill, North Carolina. The High School Ethics Bowl helps students develop critical thinking skills while discussing complex moral and ethical issues. Through endeavors such as these, we aim to help as many children as possible achieve a strong moral sensibility and appreciation for learning.

The Masonic Youth Orders also received continued support. The Education Endowment Fund made available \$180,000 in scholarships to ninety students. We contributed another \$250,000 to the University of Oklahoma's Leadership Summit to bring the endowment to \$500,000.

Our focus isn't only on students when it comes to education, and we value our educators. The Payne Education Center was awarded a \$42,500 grant to provide training and teach best practices to teachers in instructing students with dyslexia and other reading difficulties. Additionally, we sponsored the Oklahoma Teacher of the Year Awards and Arts for Excellence ceremonies to honor the significant contributions of our state educators. Oklahoma is one of the hungriest states in the nation, with 61% of Oklahoma students on reduced lunch programs. Most people served by food banks are chronically hungry children, retirees on a fixed income, and hardworking families who can't make ends meet. Every year Lodges across the state participate in the Food for Kids Program of the **Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma** and **Community Food Bank of Eastern Oklahoma**. Additionally, the Senior Feeding Programs of the Regional Food Bank received \$14,000, and the Community Food Bank received \$7,000.

We also honor the military. **The Dale Graham Veterans Foundation** received \$25,000 for services, rides, and other necessities. The **YMCA Military Welcome Center**, located at Will Rogers World Airport, received a \$10,000 grant to assist the traveling serviceman with a hot meal and place to relax while traveling through Oklahoma. It is my immense privilege to have the honor of representing the Fraternity and the Masonic Charity Foundation of Oklahoma.

# Grand Master

Robert G. Davis is a native of northwest Oklahoma, having been raised on a family farm three miles west of the Great Salt Plains in Alfalfa County. He was initiated, passed, and raised a Master Mason in his father's lodge, Corinthian Lodge #307, in August, 1969. After earning a Master of Science Degree in Economics at Oklahoma State University, he spent 14 years in the City Planning and City Management profession in Enid. In 1986, he was invited to become the General Secretary of the Guthrie Scottish Rite Bodies, where he served for 30 years, retiring in 2016. He and his wife Sharon have two daughters and five grandchildren.

He is a Past Master of Garfield #501, Albert Pike #162, and Guildhall #553. He is a 33° Mason, and recipient of the Grand Cross., and is the Chief Adept of the Oklahoma College, Masonic Rosicrucians. He is a Past Grand High Priest of Royal Arch Masons and Past Grand Commander of the Knights Templar in Oklahoma. He is Past Sovereign of Saint Omar Conclave of the Red Cross of Constantine, Past Sovereign Master of the Allied Masonic Degrees, Past Chief of Knight Masons, Past Preceptor of Knight Templar Priests, Past Prior, Knight York Cross of Honor, Past President, Order of High Priesthood, and Past Governor of the Oklahoma York Rite College. He has served on the Board of Directors of the Oklahoma Masonic Charity Foundation since 1982.

Nationally, he is on the Education Committee of the York Rite Sovereign College of North America, the Masonic Education and Research Committee, and the Rituals and Ritualistic Matters Committee of the United Grand Imperial Council of the Red Cross of Constantine, and is on the Board of Directors of the Scottish Rite Research Society. He also serves on the Steering Committee of the Masonic Information Center of the United States.

Most Worshipful Brother Davis was installed on November 15, 2020 as the 111th brother to serve as Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Oklahoma; and the 151st brother to preside over Masonry in the three Grand Jurisdictions that have represented the geographic area of our State. While serving in the City Management and City Planning professions, and as a director of the Scottish Rite, he has also enjoyed an extensive career in community volunteerism and board participation across a wide range of public and private non-profit organizations; including Board of Director positions with United Way, Chambers of Commerce, Community Industrial Foundations, Economic Development organizations, civic clubs, arts and humanities councils, summer youth arts boards, childhood literacy organizations, eldercare, mentally handicapped group home boards, home health care planning committees, public transportation authority, community traffic committee, park board, library board, city futures committee and central business district committees. He has also served in almost every capacity as a church volunteer. In Guthrie, Davis is past president of the Guthrie Education Foundation and the Lions Club. He has served two terms on the City Council of the City of Guthrie, where he was Chairman of the Finance Committee and Chairman of the Guthrie Industrial Development Authority. He currently is the Chair of the Fee and Rate Structure Advisory Committee to the city council.

At the state level he has served on the State Arts Council Grants Review Board; and has served as the Governor's delegate to the Congress for Arts and Humanities. He has also been a presenter at several Volunteer Oklahoma conferences on the subject of fundraising for non-profit organizations, grant writing and board communications. Robert's vocation in life has been one of servant leadership. At a young age, he adopted a motto penned by the American inventor, Charles F. Kettering; "My interest is in the future because I am going to spend the rest of my life there." It remains a worthy maxim today and deserves the attention of every Freemason.

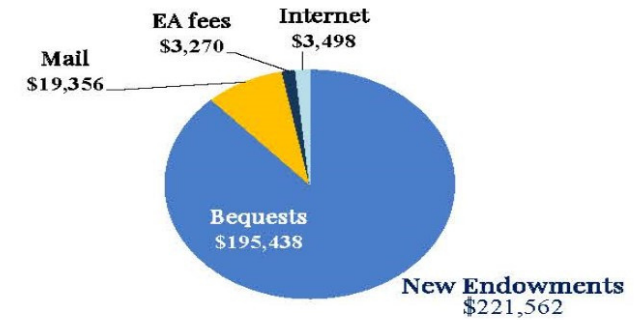
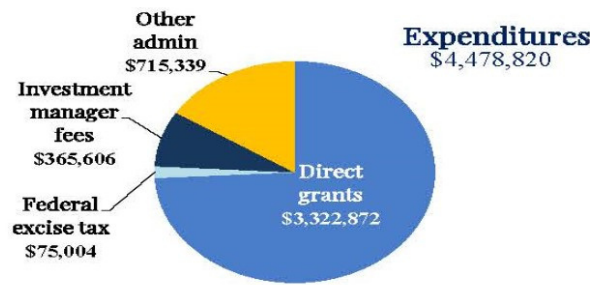
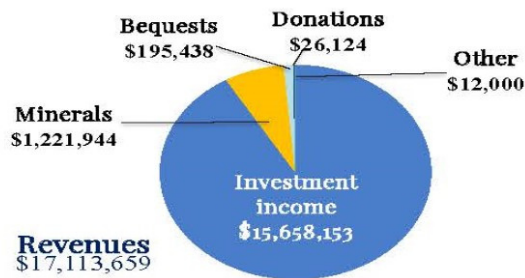

# Financial Report - Calendar Year 2019



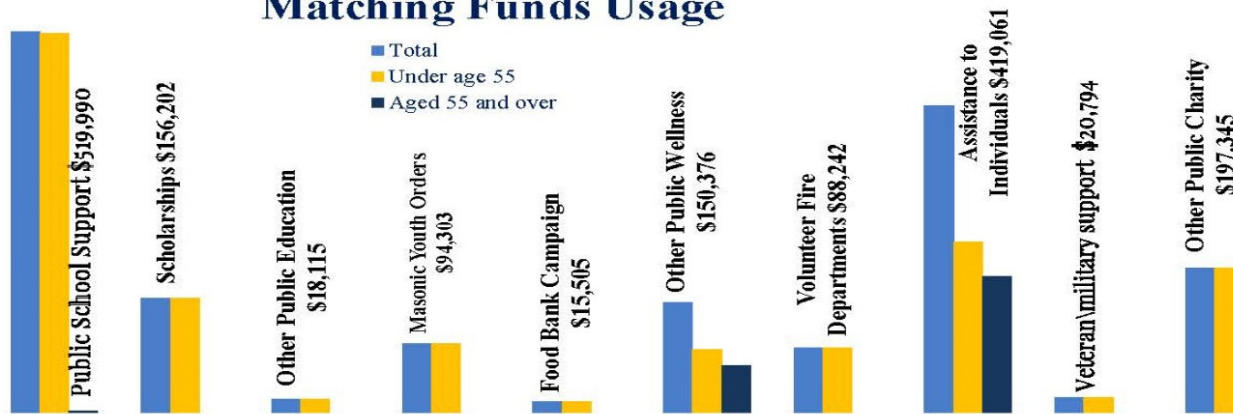
## Program Expenditures



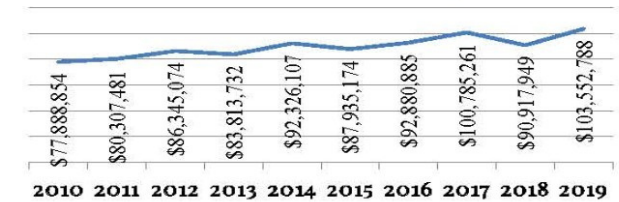
## Change in Net Assets

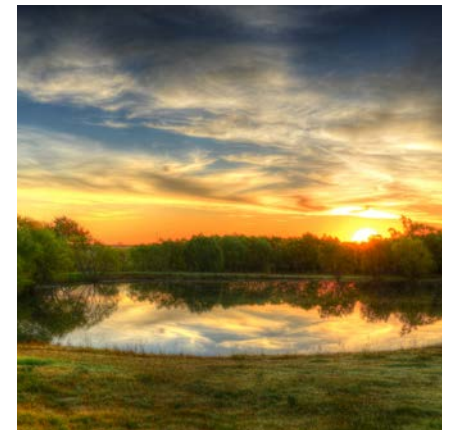
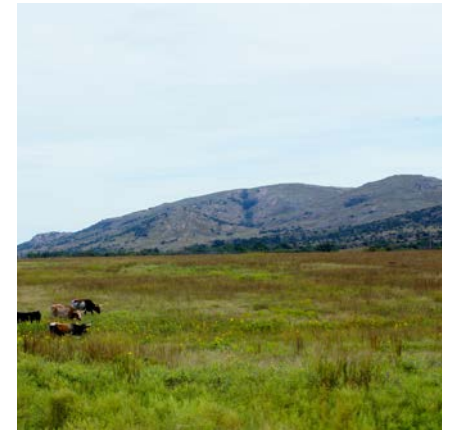
